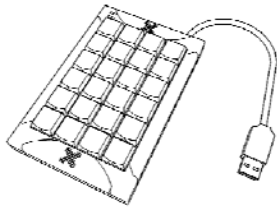


X-keys® XK-24 Specifications (XK-24-USB-R)

The X-keys® XK-24 features 24 keys with independent backlighting, a co-injected case with soft sides suitable for hand-held applications, and a profile which is equally attractive in portrait or landscape orientation. Two snap in feet give the XK-24 a slight angle on the desk top.

The XK-24 comes with MacroWorks 3 software for Windows and ControllerMate software for Mac OS-X. New Pi3 firmware in the XK-24 supports direct communication for the software developer and also features a new Reflector Mode and our standard Hardware Mode, saving all programming in an onboard non-volatile memory and emulating a USB keyboard, mouse, or game controller.
